Pharmacy Student Clinical Training for Hospital Infection Control

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I describe an ideal method for linking university pharmacy education and clinical pharmacy training. Within the clinical environment there are many problems that must be solved by the pharmacist. When pharmacy students undergo clinical training they will discover and take note of such issues. In future it will be necessary for pharmacy education to equip students with the ability to solve problems scientifically. However it is difficult to perform basic research in the hospital. Therefore cooperation between the hospital and university is required so that educational roles are divided in order for basic pharmacy research to take place at university and clinical training to take place in the hospital.
